

Fundraising online

Now the most popular and easy way of fundraising thanks to websites such as JustGiving.com. Here you can select the charity you wish to fundraise for and the page will automatically send funds to the charity. Meaning you won't need to withdraw any funds from the page, as the charity will have already received them!

Here at Skyline we will check fundraising pages 1 week prior to your jump. You will need to have your pre-set target raised and showing in 'online donations' on your page, to ensure your skydive will be 'free'.

Deadlines

We would ask that all donations and targets are completed 1 week prior to your jump date. If you need an extension please do contact us at info@skylineevents.co.uk.

If we are unaware that you need an extension or you do not meet the deadline, we can not guarantee you won't be charged full price on the day.

Sponsorship forms and cash

If you are taking pledges through sponsorship forms, ideally you would need to collect the cash prior to the jump and donate at least your target amount to the charity. You can then send us an email confirmation of your donation so we can mark you as a 'free' skydive.

If you would prefer to collect from your pledgers after your skydive, you will need to pay for the skydive and the sponsorship to the charity yourself. Then you can reimburse yourself with the money you collect after.

Please do not bring any cash donations to the airfield as they will not accept them. You may bring a cheque addressed to the charity for the sponsorship amount ONLY (aka your Fundraising target minus the skydive cost).
